Teausurers Report:

Closing Balance at December 31, 2012 was \$2398.77.

Budget for 2013 prepared and attached.

Moved: That ORWC allocate \$1000.00 for Convention.Conference sponsorships in 2013. S. Carried.

Moved: that ORWC allocate \$500.00 towards Political Action, particularly WE ARE ALL AFFECTED campaign and the event planned for March 2, 2013. S.Carried. Motion to adopt the budget. S. Carried.

International Women's Day: The Committee has been approached by Amnesty group in Vernon as there is no longer a Women's Centre in Vernon.

Moved by Darrell-Lee McKenzie: That the ORWC make donations of a maximum of \$200.00 for each of three events for International Women's Day, one in Vernon, one in Penticton and one in Kelowna.

The maximum donation amount to total \$600.00 from the ORWC.

Roberta will draft up a sheet about the ORWC, who we are, and what we do, along with information on International Women's Day. Kelly has a template and will send it to Roberta. Roberta will email the information to all members of ORWC and request they distribute it widely in their Locals.

Kelly brought information regarding Dreamweaver Scarves. The project is run by a

volunteer, Carmen Denby, who works with children to make the scarves. The proceeds support social justice iniatives. She is a World Vision Volunteer, lives in Kelowna, and makes scarves from recycled materials. The cost is \$20.00 a scarf. If we purchase the scarves, the proceeds will go towards the purchase of items for an orphanage in Colima Mexico.

Moved by Kelly: That ORWC order 10 scarves, and pay for 1/2 the cost from our budget. The members of ORWC will pay the remaining 1/2 share individually, or we find funding. The colours should be similar to those in our logo: turquiose, blue, green, yellow and pink.

Seconded: Susan. Carried.

Kelly noted that it would be great to have and wear our scarves at the upcoming B C Women's Conference May 3-5, 2013.

B C Regional Women's Conference:
